ADMINISTRATIVE RULE NO. 2020-02

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General
Manager/Engineer

The following Administrative Rule is promulgated by the SWA General Manager/Engineer for implementation and enforcement of the business recycling and organics recycling requirements in SWA Code.

Administrative Rule 2007-02 is rescinded and replaced in its entirety by this Administrative Rule 2020-02.

Franchisee Customer List and Level of Service

All SWA Franchisees shall include the following customer account information.

1. Name of business or entity being provided service.
2. Address of service location.
3. Phone number of service location (if available).
4. Billing address of business or entity being provided service (if different than (#2) above).
5. Name and phone number of business or entity point of contact.
6. Collection service level (trash, recycling and/or organics) and frequency.

The General Manager/Engineer, or his/her designee, will prescribe the format for submittal of the above information.

The first customer list will be due on July 15, 2020, and thereafter, the 15th of every month following the end of a calendar quarter: October 15th, January 15th, April 15th, and July 15th.


SWA Exemption List

SWA will provide monthly to all SWA Franchisees a list of business or entity locations for which SWA has granted an exemption pursuant to Section 4.01.150 of the SWA Code. Such exemptions are more particularly described in Assembly Bills 1826 (Chapter 727, Statutes

of 2014) or 341 (Chapter 476, Statutes of 2011). As exempted, these locations do not require separate recyclable material and/or organics recycling collection service. The list will only include, for each location, the customer name, street address, and waiver status; it will not include any additional collection service data.

SWA will release such list consistent with the requirements of the Public Records Act, and will protect all customer account information exempted from disclosure under the Act.

Under the authority of SWA Code, Section 4.01.160.A, the General Manager/Engineer is authorized to make and enforce administrative rules and regulations. Administrative Rule No. 2020-02 was received and filed by the Sacramento Regional Solid Waste Authority Clerk of the Board on July 8, 2020 and becomes effective July 8, 2020.
